WHAT IS THE CHRISM MASS

On Holy Thursday morning (in our dioceses it will be on Monday of Holy Week), the bishop, joined by the priests of the diocese, gather at the Cathedral to celebrate the Chrism Mass. This Mass manifests the unity of the priests with their bishop. Here the bishop blesses three oils — the oil of catechumens (*oleum catechumenorum* or *oleum sanctorum*), the oil of the infirm (*oleum infirmorum*) and holy chrism (*sacrum chrisma*) — which will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the diocese for the year. <https://catholicexchange.com/what-is-the-chrism-mass>

Jesus asked St. Faustina that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena of Chaplets to the Divine Mercy, which would begin on Good Friday. In her diary, St. Faustina wrote that Jesus told her: "On each day of the novena you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls and you will immerse them in this ocean of My mercy... On each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My passion, for the graces for these souls. By this novena I will grant every possible grace to souls."
