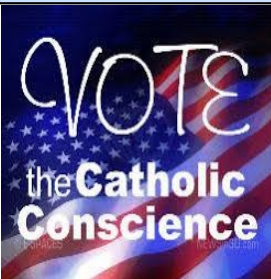
COMMUNICATION RESOURCES

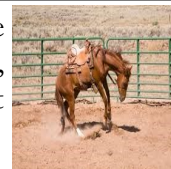
