WEEDS AND WHEAT

Summary: If we ask, "why is there evil in the world?" we must also ask "why is there good in the world?" We get our answers this Sunday: Beginning with pre-history "while everybody was asleep" (Matthew 13:24-30), the weeds represent the enemies of



God, who are: Satan, demons, and humans who definitively choose self-exclusion from God, and the wheat are those who cooperate with or are open to God. This parable doesn't mean that we tolerate all sorts of bad behavior. Jesus doesn't condone weeds. The weeds are toxic. The type of weed in the parable is called darnel, and it is a poisonous weed. Nevertheless, this is a parable of hope that weedy tendencies can decrease or be weeded-out.


