QUEENSHIP OF MARY: This Saturday, August 15 we celebrated the Assumption of Mary, and this coming Saturday, August 22, brings about the celebration of the Queenship of Mary.



This coming Saturday marks the eighth day, or the octave, after her Assumption into Heaven, so we now celebrate her coronation and queenship. Mary's Son, Jesus, is the King of the Universe (we celebrate this special feast the last Sunday in Ordinary Time, right before the start of Advent), so it follows that being the mother of the King of the Universe makes her a queen. Through Jesus, Mary becomes queen while still remaining subordinate to Jesus. As our Heavenly Queen, Mary holds a very special role within the work of salvation: she prays and intercedes for us. Early Church Fathers and the faithful have invoked Mary's intercession through the title of her queenship since the earliest centuries of the Church.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES: We would like to share a few reminders with you per the Diocese of Bismarck Directives.
