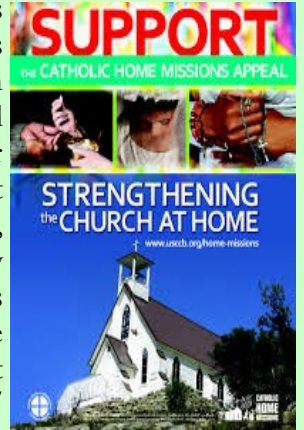

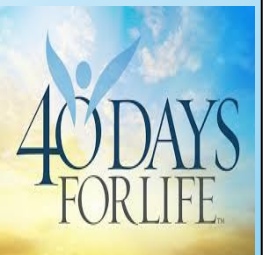
63RD ANNUAL GOD SHARE APPEAL
