National Grandparents' Day is celebrated on the first Sunday after Labor Day. If you're lucky enough to have your grandparents around, take this opportunity to appreciate them.

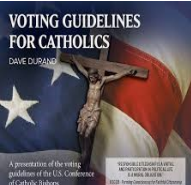

2020 GOD'S SHARE APPEAL

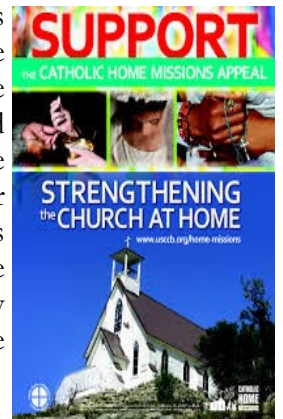
SEPTEMBER 12-13, 2020

DIOCESE OF BISMARCK DIRECTIVES FOR COVID-19

- *Stay home if you are feeling ill.
- *Hand Sanitizer is always available at the entrance. Please sanitize your hands as you enter the building.
- *Face Masks are not required to enter the building or to attend Mass, but we strongly encourage you to wear one for your safety and the safety of others around you.
