

Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother; to thee do I come; before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. During November, remember to keep the faithful departed in your prayers. Our parish will remember them in the petitions at every Mass. Remember, praying for the dead is a spiritual work of mercy! An Indulgence may be obtained for anyone who visits a cemetery and prays for the faithful departed at the cemetery between November 1<sup>st</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>. Due to the pandemic the pope has extended the days that were in the past from November 1<sup>st</sup> to November 8<sup>th</sup>.

Conditions to obtain this indulgence are:

1. Do the work while in a state of grace,
2. Receive the Sacrament of Confession and the Holy Communion,
3. Prayer a Our Father and Hail Mary for the intentions of our pope.

### THE HOLY SOULS OF PURGATORY

The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life, but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St. Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, "even as others who have no hope ... For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven ... and the dead who are in Christ shall rise.

The Church has always taught us to pray for those who have gone into eternity. Even in the Old Testament prayers and alms were offered for the souls of the dead by those who thought "well and religiously concerning the resurrection." It was believed that "they who had fallen asleep with godliness had great grace laid up for them" and that "it is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins."
