

St. Anthony Food Pantry

Our parish food pantry is a welcoming, dependable source of nutritious food, respect and social contact to the needy of our community. Currently, we procure food from donations made by our devoted parishioners as well as grocery restocking 4-5 times a year. Monies used for grocery restocking is from St. Anthony donations made throughout the year.

Volunteers responsibilities would include:

- Distribution support
- Pick-up, organization, inventory and pantry stocking
- Monthly grocery pick-up bag preparations.
- Transporting donated food items from the Church to the Food Pantry building
- Notifying the Parish Office Manager when the shelves are needing replenishment
- Place grocery restocking orders
- Being present for the monthly grocery pick-up by enrolled St. Anthony families
- Procure paper grocery bags with handles for the bags prepared

We rely on parishioners' support...donations of non-perishable food, toiletries, sturdy shopping bags, and monetary donations.

The St. Anthony Food Pantry ministry engages the support of many parishioners, neighbors, and friends of the parish. We are always open to new volunteers and welcome newcomers
