**ADMINISTRATOR'S
CORNER**

31st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

This Sunday's first reading (Wisdom 11:22-12:2) describes God as a lover of life. He is compassionate to all. He is merciful to all. He overlooks sins and gives His children time to repent. By degrees, He corrects those who sin so that they may trust in Him again.

The second reading (2Thessalonians 1:11-2:2) tells us that constant prayers were offered for the Thessalonians who experienced difficulties in their faith due to the deceptive preaching of some visionaries. Paul encouraged them to glorify God by keeping purposes and works which their faith prompts them to do.

In our Gospel today Zacchaeus, who was a chief tax collector and a wealthy man, was seeking to see Jesus but could not see him because there were too many people and at the same time, he is small in stature. He climbed up

on a tree and when Jesus saw him, he called him down and ask him to stay in his house. Many grumbled because Zacchaeus was a tax collector and a public sinner but Jesus told them that salvation has come to this home because he came to seek and save the lost.

God is a loving God, he is full of mercy and compassion. He overlooks our sins and always gives us the chance to repent. God's love sustains and holds us into being of every moment. Gives us the breath of life. it is He who takes the initiative to approach us, all the way.

The tree is Zacchaeus' comfort zone. We all have our own trees of comfort but what ever tree we climb we need to come down to meet Jesus and to embrace him, because salvation awaits us. Jesus looks for us and invites us and we respond through our gift of faith. As we humbly journey towards God's heart, we welcome the Son of Man, and salvation has come. The grace of God is overflowing, it is abundant, it is up to us to draw from that grace, for we are called to it, and may we receive it and proclaim it to the world.

God is good. All the time!
