Trustworthy Stewards
Stewardship Series
(2 of 3)

At the time Jesus said, 'It is finished.' And when he breathed his last, a soldier thrust his lance on his side, immediately blood and water flowed from his side (cf *John 19:30-34*). The gift of the Christ's pierced side: The WATER and BLOOD symbolizes our BAPTISM and the EUCHARIST.

It is through the waters of Baptism and the Blood of the Eucharist that is the Birth of Community. Through the sacrament of Baptism we are incorporated in the Christian Community and through the sacrament of the Eucharist, we become One Body - a Christian Community in Worship and in life with Christ as the Head (*Galatians 3:27-28*).

This Community of Faith was born through the waters of Baptism, was purchased by the Blood of Christ. We came from Calvary! We are related not by "blood", not by ethnicity, not by citizenship, but by faith (cf *Galatians 3:27-28, Acts 20:28, 1 Corinthians*

3:4-9). What occurs in the Community of Faith then, what do they do? Their possessions were held in common. There was no needy person among them. They ate their meals in exultation, praising God. They brought money from property sold at the feet of the apostles. They increased in number. We help each other for Christ. We share because of Christ. The source is Christ and nothing else (*Acts 4:32-37*).

With the first Community of Faith, sharing of their time, talent and treasure is essential in the building of a strong relationship among them. Gathering together, sharing their gifts of time, talent and treasure is no longer a burden for the community, no longer an obligation. They are happier and fulfilled...it became a way of life.
