In our first reading (Is 58:7-10) the prophet Isaiah reminds us to do good and be kind to our neighbors especially those who are in need and our light shall break forth like the dawn. And it also tells us to bestow the bread to the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday.

In our second reading (1 Cor 2:1-5) the writer exhorts that he came not to scare or threaten the people but explained to them the he came to announce the mystery of Christ crucified.

In Our Gospel (Mt 5: 13-16) this Sunday, Jesus tells us to be the salt of the earth: we are to season the world with flavor of Christianity; we are to preserve Christian principles and gospel values; and we are to promote healing and reconciliation where
