We are nearly half way through the season of Lent and we may be finding it harder to stay focused on our Lenten practices and sacrifices. But there is one person we can look to most especially during this year as we continue through this Lenten season.

We are currently in the Year of St. Joseph. On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis proclaimed a Year of St. Joseph that would run from December 8, 2020 – December 8, 2021. This is a year of devotion to St. Joseph and every Catholic is encouraged to go take up a devotion to him.

**EXCERPTS FROM US BISHOP CHAIRMEN FOR DOCTRINE  
AND FOR PRO-LIFE ADDRESS  
THE USE OF JOHNSON & JOHNSON  
COVINE-19 VACCINE**

WASHINGTON— On March 2, Bishop Kevin C. Rhoades of Fort Wayne-South Bend, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops’ (USCCB) Committee on Doctrine, and Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City in Kansas, chairman of the USCCB’s Committee on Pro-Life Activities, issued a statement on the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine recently approved for use in the United States.

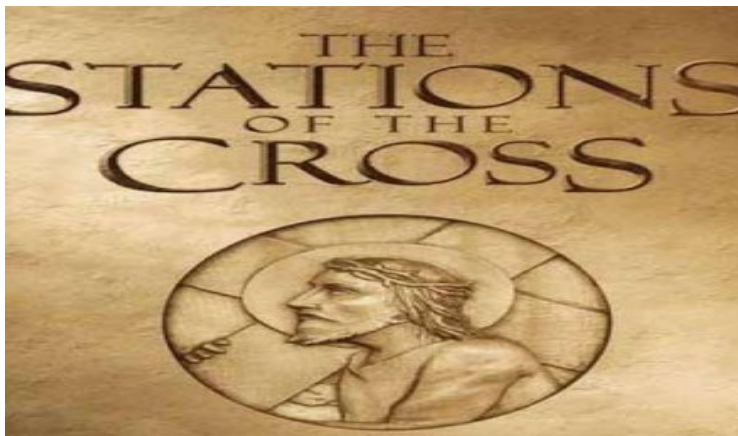
“The approval of Johnson & Johnson’s COVID-19 vaccine for use in the United States again raises questions about the moral permissibility of using vaccines developed, tested, and/or produced with the help of abortion-derived cell lines.

“Pfizer and Moderna’s vaccines raised concerns because an abortion-derived cell line was used for testing them, but not in their production. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine, however, was developed, tested and is produced with abortion-derived cell lines raising additional moral concerns.

If one can choose among equally safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines, the vaccine with the least connection to abortion-derived cell lines should be chosen. Therefore, if one has the ability to choose a vaccine, Pfizer or Moderna’s vaccines should be chosen over Johnson & Johnson’s.
