SUNDAY REFLECTION



Journey to the Summit

Blessed Palm Sunday to all,

We are now entering into the final week of Lent, Holy Week. This is the time when our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving should increase. We are called to enter more deeply into the paschal mystery that we will celebrate during the Easter Triduum.

Lent was a time of self-examination. We spent the season of Lent building our spiritual muscles and working to overcome the things that impede God’s grace and keep us from truly living for God. Now we take the final days of Lent and use it to show our increased devotion to God and to his Church.

As we close out the season of Lent and prepare to enter into the Paschal

Triduum, let us journey with Christ in his life, passion, and death and await his triumphant resurrection. As Christian disciples, we must remember that we are coheirs with him in the resurrection. Because we share in the glory of his resurrection we, too, must journey with him in his final hours. We must bear our crosses as he bore his, and accept willingly our death with him on the cross.

Remember these few words during these final days of Lent, “For God so loved the world he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.” (John 3:16), “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” (Luke 23:42). Let these verses from scripture be your prayer this week. Let it draw you closer to Christ. Let it be a reminder to you of the love that God has for you and just how far he will go to prove his love for you.

RESUMPTION OF SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

Effective Easter Sunday, April 4 (or as of the Easter Vigil, April 3), I am ending the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, which has been in effect since mid-March, 2020. However, anyone who is sick, may have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, or who has a health condition that would endanger themselves or others by being present in church, continues to be dispensed.

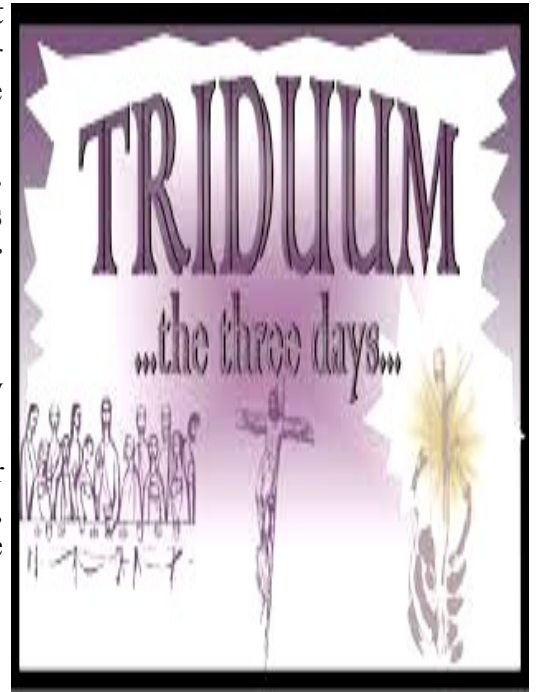

Holy Week is important as it reminds Christians of God's sacrifice of his son, and also God's love for his people. Christians can learn much about Jesus through the last **week** of his life. ... It celebrates God raising his son Jesus from the dead as well as the destruction of the power of sin and death forever.

HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE

- **Palm Sunday (Passion Sunday) March 28**
- Holy Monday and Holy Tuesday, March 29/30
- Holy Wednesday (Spy Wednesday) March 31 On the Wednesday before his death, Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the Leper. ... From this moment on, Judas sought an opportunity to betray Jesus. In reference to Judas Iscariot's intent to betray Jesus, formed on Holy Wednesday, the day is sometimes called "Spy Wednesday".
- **Maundy Holy Thursday, April 1- Masses 5:00pm & 7pm at St. Michael Church** (Maundy is derived from the Latin word for "command," and refers to Jesus' commandment to the disciples to "Love one another as I have loved you." (*Adoration to follow after 7pm Mass.*)
- **Good Friday, April 2 - Stations of the Cross, 2:15pm at St. Michael Church followed at 3:00pm The Veneration of the Cross and at 7:00pm The Veneration of the Cross at Mission of Sts. Peter & Paul.** The crucifixion of Jesus and his death at Calvary.
- **Holy Saturday (Black Saturday) April 3**
Black Saturday may refer to: Holy Saturday, the day between Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
- **Easter Vigil, April 3 - 7:00pm at St. Michael Church.** Only after the solemn vigil during the night, held in anticipation of the resurrection, does the Easter celebration begin, with a spirit of joy that overflows into the following period of fifty days.
- **Easter Sunday, April 4 - Regular Sunday Masses**
Reservations must be made for each day.

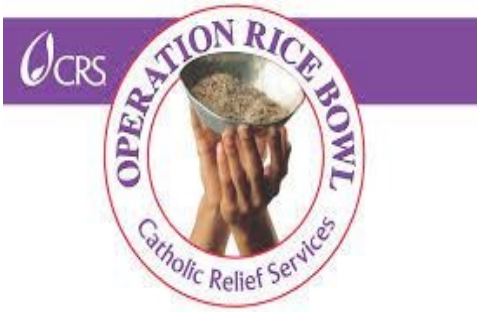
