**SUNDAY REFLECTION**



**True Body  
True Blood**

Today is the feast of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, more popularly known as Corpus Christi. Today, as a Church, we profess our belief in the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist. A few years ago the Pew Research Center ran a study on the Catholic belief in the Eucharist. The study found that only 1/3 of Catholics actually believe in transubstantiation (change in substance). This is the Catholic belief that at the moment of consecration the bread and wine are no longer bread and wine, but that they are truly Jesus’ body and blood.

As Catholics, we must believe in the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist. To deny the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist is to deny the very basis of our faith. Many of our protestant brothers and sisters see the Eucharist merely as a symbol, but the Church definitively teaches that Christ is truly present, body and blood, soul and divinity. It also teaches that the Eucharist is the source and

summit of our faith that all our sacraments and all our belief stems from.

It is hard to believe that something so meek and humble like bread and wine can actually be Christ’s body and blood, but we are talking about a God who humbled himself and became a child. We are talking about a God who took upon himself the sins of all humanity and was crucified though innocent. As the bible so clearly preaches, nothing is as it seems.

It is vital as Catholics to profess a belief in the true presence of Christ so much so our souls depend on it. Every time we gather around the Eucharistic table we hear the very words of Christ that were said at the last supper, “TAKE AND EAT ... TAKE AND DRINK.” It is by these very words that the very bread and wine we see, eat, and drink is changed forever into the body, blood, soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. Although visibly we see bread and wine, substantially bread and wine no longer exist and all that exist is the Christ himself present in the most holy sacrament of the altar. It is by this we profess our faith in Christ Jesus.

## LATIN MASS WITH FR. RICHARD MCNALLY - JUNE 13—2:00PM @ST. MICHAEL

The Traditional Rite of the Mass, currently known as the Extraordinary Form of the Latin Rite, developed organically from the time of the Apostles with the prayers, blessings and music written by Saints, theologians and pope's of the Catholic Church's two-thousand year history.

The Traditional Mass places great emphasis on the sacrificial nature of the Mass and the true presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Those attending will note its quiet and prayerful atmosphere which allow one to pray in an un-distracted way, thereby participating in the liturgy in an authentic manner. They will also notice that the priest faces the altar for the majority of the Divine Liturgy, turning to the congregation only for certain prayers and blessings. Its beauty has been recognized by the greatest poets, saints and scholars as "**The most beautiful thing this side of heaven.**"

The Church Latin used during the Mass was chosen as the best and highest form of language.
