Dear Parents,

On February 10th– February 12th, St. Brendan's will host its annual science fair. This is a great opportunity for students from grades K-8 to display their talents in the various fields of science. Participation is **optional for grades K-4 only**. All students must work within their grade level and may work in groups **no larger than 3**.

Each project will be judged and one winner from each grade will represent St. Brendan's at the Bronx Catholic Schools Science Fair. The Bronx Science Fair will be held at Mount St. Michael Academy.

Projects will be judged on, and **MUST** include the following:

- **Title** – A brief, descriptive title, 40 letters or less.
- **Hypothesis** – What did I think would happen?
- **Method** – What did I do (what steps did I take) to answer the question?
- **Data** – Have ready whatever you used to keep records of what you were studying (for example: charts, pencil marks, etc). This is optional for grades K-3 **ONLY**.
- **Conclusion** – What did happen? What did you learn? If you had to do this over, what would you change?

Projects that do not contain the above information or are not submitted on February 10th **cannot** be judged.

The student must be able to speak on the experiment:

- **Grades K-3: 1 minute**
- **Grades 4-8: 3 minutes**

Students are urged to use a display board. These boards can be purchased for \$5. If you are interested in purchasing a board, please have your child fill out the form below and return it to their homeroom teacher.
