SEL Morning Meet-Up Online with Teacher

A teacher-led warm-up that facilitates conversation and prepares the class for learning together

Reading and Math Online with Teacher

Core content instruction focused on foundational standards necessary for grade level promotion. Additional daily phonics instruction is provided to young learners



Brain Breaks Online with Teacher

Opportunities to stretch, breathe, and socialize with classmates



Enrichment Online with Teacher

Rotating activities that focus on STEAM, social studies, music, robotics, and coding
