A. Opening Prayer: Jerry McConnell

- B) CALL TO SERVE: Stewardship committee members here tonight. Scott discussed the 'Call To Serve' forms. Disappointed that only 160 forms were returned (about 10%). The weekend breakdown is: 116 forms returned the first weekend, 30 forms the second weekend and 14 forms the third weekend. Some thought that if you were already a member of a ministry the form did not have to be filled out. Not expecting anyone to drop the ministries they are in (if they did not fill out a form). As an example, the Coffee and Donuts ministry had only 2 new parishioners interested. Scott said the form is available online to fill out, but each member of a family has to fill it out separately. Discussed sending out another email reminding people to send in the form or fill it out online. The form is 'buried' on the website, it was suggested to move it to a more visible place. To increase response the priest could, during the announcements at mass, continue to remind parishioners to return the forms. Forms are in the Narthex but should also be by the entrance near the cry room. Mentioned putting the forms in the pews or on windshields of cars. Emails will be sent out to those who did return the form, thanking them and telling them that someone from the ministries they indicated will be contacting them.
