- 2) A completed and updated Service Request Form must also be submitted for the 2020-2021 school year along with an attachment of the Terms and Conditions page located under your FACTS profile.
- 3) Reminder, tuition payments must be received no later than the 5th or 20th of each month to maintain good standing and avoid interruptions in your child's classes.
