Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

In a recent address at the Vatican, Pope Francis spoke about the importance of Christians becoming, being and maintaining throughout their life an evangelism that leads others to Jesus. He stated that we all should be grateful to the Lord for freeing us from our old ways and helping us find our family within the Church. According to him we need to realize that we found new life in the Church through our Baptism so that we can begin to discover the tender love of God, Our Father.

Pope Francis said: "We often thank God for His gifts, for what He gives us, and it is good to do so. But it is even better to thank Him for what He is, because He is the God Who is faithful in love. His goodness does not depend on us. Whatever we do, God continues to love us faithfully. This is the source of our faith, the great consolation of life. So. Take courage, never be saddened! And when the clouds of problems seem to thicken heavily over your days, remember that the faithful love of God always shines like the sun that does not set. Remember His goodness, stronger than all evil; and the gentle memory of God's love will help you in anguish.

...Herein lies the strength of the message, so the world may believe. What counts is not arguments that convince but life that attracts; not the capacity to impose

but the courage to serve. And you have it in your DNA, this vocation to proclaim by living as family, after the example of the Holy Family: in humility, simplicity and praise. You carry this familial atmosphere in many places that are desolate and devoid of love. Make yourselves known as friends of Jesus. Call everyone friends and be a friend to everyone.

'Go and make disciples of all people.' And when Jesus says all, He apparently wishes to emphasize that there is room for all people in His heart. No one is excluded. See with the heart, with a gaze that appreciates, an approach that respects, a faith that waits patiently... because the Lord is at home with each people and His Spirit has already sown the seeds before you. May you be inspired by humanity, working together for the joy of all, respected because you are neighbors, listened to because you are close. May you love without applying pre-established models...and looking to His paternal, fraternal and loving faithfulness, never lose faith!"

As "living stones" of His Church, let us take to heart the words of our Holy Father and follow his guidance to bring the Good News of Salvation to all we meet. Peace be with you, Monsignor

DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

En un reciente discurso en el Vaticano, el Papa Francisco habló sobre la importancia de que los cristianos se conviertan, sean y mantengan a lo largo de su vida un evangelismo que lleve a otros a Jesús. Él declaró que todos deberíamos estar agradecidos al Señor por liberarnos de nuestras viejas costumbres y ayudarnos a encontrar a nuestra familia dentro de la Iglesia. Según él, debemos darnos cuenta de que encontramos una nueva vida en la Iglesia a través de nuestro Bautismo para poder comenzar a descubrir el tierno amor de Dios, nuestro Padre.

El Papa Francisco dijo: "A menudo agradecemos a Dios por sus dones, por lo que Él nos da, y es bueno hacerlo. Pero es aún mejor agradecerle por lo que es, porque Él es el Dios que es fiel en el amor. Su bondad no depende de nosotros. Hagamos lo que hagamos, Dios continúa amándonos fielmente. Esta es la fuente de nuestra fe, el gran consuelo de la vida. Así que. ¡Toma coraje, nunca te entristeces! Y cuando las nubes de problemas parezcan espesarse durante sus días, recuerde que el amor fiel de Dios siempre brilla como el sol que no se pone. Recuerda su bondad, más fuerte que todo mal; y el suave recuerdo del amor de Dios te ayudará en la angustia.

... Aquí reside la fuerza del mensaje, para que el mundo pueda creer. Lo que cuenta no son los argumentos que convencen sino la vida que atrae; no la capacidad de imponer, sino el coraje de servir. Y lo tienes en tu DNA, esta vocación de proclamar viviendo en familia, según el ejemplo de la Sagrada Familia: en humildad, sencillez y alabanza. Ustedes llevan esta atmósfera familiar en muchos lugares que están desolados y desprovistos de amor. Hazte conocer como amigos de Jesús. Llama a todos tus amigos y sé un amigo para todos.

"Id y haced discípulos a todas las personas." Y cuando Jesús lo dice todo, aparentemente desea enfatizar que hay lugar para todas las personas en Su corazón. Nadie está excluido. Mira con el corazón, con una mirada que aprecia, un enfoque que respeta, una fe que espera pacientemente ... porque el Señor está en casa con cada pueblo y Su Espíritu ya ha sembrado las semillas ante ti. Que estés inspirado por la humanidad, trabajando juntos para la alegría de todos, respetado porque eres un prójimo, escuchado porque estás cerca. Que ames sin aplicar modelos preestablecidos ... y mirando a su fidelidad paternal, fraterna y amorosa, nunca ¡Perder la fe!"

Como "piedras vivas" de Su Iglesia, tomemos en serio las palabras de nuestro Santo Padre y sigamos su guía para llevar las Buenas Nuevas de la Salvación a todos los que encontramos.
