Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

This coming week contains two feast days: St. Vincent de Paul on the 27th and the Archangels on the 29th. St. Vincent is of course dear to our hearts here in Anderson because of his patronage of the St. Vincent de Paul Society and the work they do to help our poor. Please take advantage of the opportunity to thank the St. Vincent volunteers if you see them this week.

We also celebrate the Archangels: Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. Angels are mysterious to us and, even though each of us has a guardian angel, we know very few by name. This feast gives us the opportunity to praise God for the full spectrum of His Creation and reflect upon the importance of the angels in our lives and throughout history.

In years past, September 29th was called Michaelmas and focused only on St. Michael (Gabriel and Rafael joined him during the last century). Each of these three angels is spoken of in Scripture and reveal aspects of God's will for us.

Raphael, whose name means "God heals" is found in the Book of Tobit. He accompanies and protects Tobit on his journey, eventually healing him of blindness.

Gabriel ("God is my strength") is well known to us for his message to Our Lady at the Annunciation. It is beautiful to see the angel delivering the message that our Savior was to come. We sinned and needed Jesus. It is good to see that, like God, the angels did not abandon us after our failures. Instead, Gabriel cooperated with God's will and declared the greatest news we have ever received.

Michael ("Who is like God") fights with the Enemy and casts him out of Heaven. Michael is seen as the guardian of the Church and his powerful intercession protects us from the efforts of the Enemy.

This week we reflect on St. Vincent and our mission to serve the needs of our brothers and sisters. It is fitting that we also recognize the intercession and influence of the Archangels. While we strive to imitate St. Vincent in serving others, may we have the humility and joy of receiving the help of the angels.
