Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord:

As part of my Fortieth Anniversary celebration I received the following reflection from parishioners. As of this writing I have not been able to get their permission for printing their names, so I will share this from my favorite source, anonymous. The author of the reflection is Father Ben Syberg, Pastor of Our Lady of the Springs in French Lick, Indiana. It is a Prayer of Daily Consecration for Priests which he wrote.

“One day within Your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere. Lord Jesus Christ, on the day You ordained me a priest, On the day Your consecration was my consecration, on the day Your priesthood became my priesthood, on the day Your hands and the hands of the Bishop were truly one, Truly on that day You decreed: You are a priest forever. Yes, Lord, a priest forever, but a priest on that day and still a priest today.

I say yes to the priesthood today. My hands are your hands today. My life is Your life today. Lord You promise that tomorrow will take care of itself, All I need be is a priest today. If today I would hear Your voice, your call, just for today. Help me today, to be holy, to pray with fervor, to be gentle and kind. To be patient, to be free of anxiety, to be strong, to be ready to serve.

May today I take up the Sacred Host and Saving Chalice and know that they are unmarred—even by all the world’s troubles. May I this day befriend sinners, extending pardon and peace. May I this day bring hope and grace to the sick, the poor, and to the weary. May I know this day what life and joy I can bring to my little flock, for they are Your gift to me. May I know peace and simple joy this day, and not miss the little miracles You send me. May I know that I am not the Savior, that I will fall again and again—yet still today You call me.

Lord, no one can make a perfect Yes. But today I renew priesthood once more; I say Yes again. For today I dwell in Your courts, and it is better than thousands elsewhere.”

The reflection helps one who is called to service in the Priesthood of Christ to remember the teaching of Saint Anthony of Padua: Give all of yourself to God and God will give you all of Himself. Thanks to all of you, friends and foe alike, who continue to call forth the gift of faith and walk together to the Kingdom of the Father. May God bless us all.

## DESDE EL PASTOR

Queridas Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

Como parte de la celebración de mi cuadragésimo aniversario, recibí la siguiente reflexión de los feligreses. Al momento de escribir este documento, no he podido obtener su permiso para imprimir sus nombres, por lo que compartiré esto de mi fuente favorita, anónima. El autor de la reflexión es el padre Ben Syberg, pastor de Nuestra Señora de los Manantiales en French Lick, Indiana. Es una oración de consagración diaria para los sacerdotes que escribió.

“Un día dentro de tus tribunales es mejor que mil en otro lugar. Señor Jesucristo, el día en que me ordenaste sacerdote, el día en que tu consagración fue mi consagración, el día en que tu sacerdocio se convirtió en mi sacerdocio, el día en que tus manos y las manos del Obispo fueron verdaderamente uno, en verdad en ese día Decretaste: Tú eres sacerdote para siempre. Sí, Señor, un sacerdote para siempre, pero un sacerdote en ese día y todavía un sacerdote hoy.

Hoy digo sí al sacerdocio. Mis manos son tus manos hoy. Mi vida es tu vida hoy. Señor, prometes que mañana se cuidará solo. Todo lo que necesito es un sacerdote hoy. Si hoy quisiera escuchar tu voz, tu llamada, solo por hoy. Ayúdame hoy, a ser santo, a orar con fervor, a ser amable y amable. Ser paciente, estar libre de ansiedad, ser fuerte, estar listo para servir.

Hoy puedo tomar la Hostia Sagrada y el Cáliz de Ahorro y saber que no están casados, incluso por todos los problemas del mundo. Que hoy me haga amigo de los pecadores, extendiendo el perdón y la paz. Que hoy pueda traer esperanza y gracia a los enfermos, a los pobres y a los cansados. Que pueda saber este día qué vida y alegría puedo traer a mi pequeño rebaño, porque son tu regalo para mí. Que pueda conocer la paz y la alegría simple este día, y no perder los pequeños milagros que me envías. Que pueda saber que no soy el Salvador, que caeré una y otra vez, y aún hoy me llamas.

Señor, nadie puede hacer un perfecto Sí. Pero hoy renuevo el sacerdocio una vez más; Yo digo que sí otra vez. Porque hoy habito en Tus cortes, y es mejor que miles en otros lugares ”.

La reflexión ayuda a quien está llamado a servir en el Sacerdocio de Cristo a recordar la enseñanza de San Antonio de Padua: entregúese todo a Dios y Dios se lo dará todo a Sí mismo. Gracias a todos ustedes, amigos y enemigos por igual, que continúan invocando el don de la fe y caminan juntos hacia el Reino del Padre. Que Dios nos bendiga a todos.
