Dear Family of Faith:

Venerable Paulina Jaricot became involved in missionary work through the letters that she received from her brother that told of the extreme poverty that he saw in his work as a missionary in Asia. Along with the letters, she also received a great desire to help her brother and others involved in missionary work. Thus, she decided to begin raising funds for the missions.

Her plan was to gather together a group of ten people which would mainly consist of her friends who she worked with on a daily basis. This group which was brought together in 1820 was willing to give a weekly sacrifice of 1 cent per week. Then each member of this first group of 10 was sent out to form their own group of ten, and those new members were sent out to form their own group of ten and so on and so forth. All these members eventually formed the Society of the Propagation of the Faith whose function is to help missionary efforts worldwide. Paulina Jaricot is considered the foundress of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith.

It is through our Diocesan Propagation of the Faith Office that we participate annually in the Missionary Cooperative Program (MCP). This Diocesan Office selects mission groups from a large pool of mission dioceses, religious orders and lay missionary groups from all over the country and the world.

This year we will be having a missionary coming to us from the Diocese of Kiyinda Mityana, Uganda. This particular diocese was formed in 1981.

According to recent numbers provided on the USCCB website, "The Catholic Church in Africa has tripled in size in the last 30 years but due to the economic and social hurdles of enormous debt, epidemic, severe poverty and political unrest it is difficult for the Church in Africa to sustain its growth and maintain essential outreach." Indeed, the above information does not tell about the exact condition of the mission in Uganda but I am confident that the missionary will get us acquainted with it.

Nonetheless, this mission diocese applied for assistance in writing, they were selected and now have been sent to our parishes to speak about how they live, spread and promote or propagate the Catholic Faith in their part of the world. I am looking forward to see how we can join ourselves to this mission. They will make their appeal and we are invited to discern and respond as generously as possible.

Querida familia de fe:

Venerable Paulina Jaricot se involucró en el trabajo misionero a través de las cartas que ella recibió de su hermano que hablaba de la pobreza extrema que veía en su trabajo como misionero en Asia. Junto con las cartas, también recibió un gran deseo de ayudar a su hermano y a otras personas involucradas en la obra misionera. Por lo tanto, decidió comenzar a recaudar fondos para las misiones.

Su plan consistía en reunir a un grupo de diez personas que principalmente fueron sus amigos con los que ella trabajaba en la semana. Este grupo que se reunió en 1820 estaba dispuesto a dar un sacrificio semanal de 1 centavo por semana. Y luego, cada miembro de este primer grupo de 10 personas formaron su propio grupo de diez, y luego esos nuevos miembros se enviaron para formar su propio grupo de diez y así sucesivamente. Todos estos miembros finalmente formaron la Sociedad de Propagación de la Fe, cuya función es ayudar a los esfuerzos misioneros en todo el mundo. Paulina Jaricot es considerada la fundadora de la Sociedad de la Propagación de la Fe.

A través de nuestra oficina diocesana de propagación de la fe, participamos anualmente en el Programa Cooperativo Misionero (MCP). Esta Oficina Diocesana selecciona grupos misioneros de un gran número de diócesis misioneras, órdenes religiosas y laicos grupos misioneros de todo el país y del mundo. Este año tendremos un misionero que va a venir de la Diócesis de Kiyinda Mityana, Uganda, África. Esta diócesis en particular se formó en 1981.

Según cifras recientes proporcionadas en el sitio web de USCCB, "La Iglesia Católica en África se ha triplicado en tamaño en los últimos 30 años, pero debido a los obstáculos económicos y sociales de la enorme deuda, epidemia, pobreza severa y disturbios políticos, es difícil para la Iglesia en África mantener su crecimiento y un alcance esencial. "No sé la condición exacta de esta misión en Uganda, pero estoy seguro de que el misionero nos familiarizará con ella".

No obstante, esta diócesis misionera solicitó asistencia por escrito, fue seleccionada y ahora ha sido enviada a nuestras parroquias para hablar con nosotros sobre cómo viven, evangelizan, promueven o propagan la fe católica en esta parte del mundo. Tengo muchas ganas de ver cómo podemos unirnos a esta misión. Ellos harán su solicitud a nosotros este fin de semana y se nos invita a discernir y responder lo más generoso posible .
