MONDAYS -

Young Einsteins: Tech Academy

1st – 3rd Grades

This program introduces advanced concepts of coding and engineering through playful projects and games. This is a great fundamental class and is best to learn when the students are young. Students are able to program a game or create a robot that can navigate a maze as they learn how to use math and computer coding to think creatively. This class will delight and excite the curious mind of each and every student.



Little Villagers -

Community Service Outreach Projects

TK – 8th Grades

From helping feed the homeless to brightening a senior’s day with a thoughtful gift, to supporting rescue animals with useful items, these projects give kids the opportunity to make a difference in our communities while learning valuable skills. Each week they will support a new cause with a new activity. Material and supplies are included and created at school. Parents will receive weekly updates with photos and summary of class discussion to share at home. Little Villagers will deliver items to organizations being served. Example organizations being served are CHOC, Habitat for Humanity, Colette’s Children’s Home, Pet Project, and more.



TUESDAYS - Drama Club

2nd - 8th Grades

During the program, students will learn improvisation skills and performance techniques. The students will perform for the school and for their families. Drama Club is a wonderful way for students to relax, build confidence, and improve listening and speaking skills. Middle school students are also able to serve as members of the stage crew.



WEDNESDAYS - Academic Chess

Kindergarten - 8th Grades

Exciting stories are used to teach chess concepts in a way that makes it easy to remember and fun to learn. By learning this game that is played all around the world, students will think deeply, gain confidence, solve problems, develop patience, evaluate positions, visualize results, strategize, plan, and compete with others. Lessons are tailored to the skill level of the student.



WEDNESDAYS - Children’s Choir

1st - 6th grades

Students in grades 1 - 6 may join the parish children’s choir and sing at the Sunday 10:30 Mass throughout the school year.



THURSDAYS - Junior High Choir

6th – 8th Grades

Sacred & secular music

Fall Session – “Glee Club” with 1 concert – 10 weeks

Spring Session – “Concert Choir” with 3 concerts – 14 weeks



THURSDAYS - LEGO Classes

1st - 6th Grades

This class will spark a child’s imagination and get students working with LEGOs while teaching a variety of engineering topics. Children will learn organizational and fine motor skills, as well as teamwork and other life strategies.



FRIDAYS - Strings

Kinderfiddle -

Kindergarten and 1st grade students

Students sing and memorize songs, learn mathematical concepts of music, bow movements and rhythms of traditional American folk songs, study music history and build self-confidence through group participation and performance.



Beginning Strings -

2nd through 8th grade students

Content includes beginning violin, viola or cello lessons, the care and handling of instruments, proper position and control, the production of sound, and how to read and play basic notes and music scored for orchestra. Students have opportunities to perform throughout the year.

MONDAYS & FRIDAYS - First Lego League Robotic Teams

4th - 8th Grade

SBS has two FLL Robotic Teams that compete in challenges, engaging students in research, problem solving, coding, and engineering. Season runs August to December with practices Mondays and Fridays. After competition season, teams will practice with other STEM projects working on their engineering competition skills.
