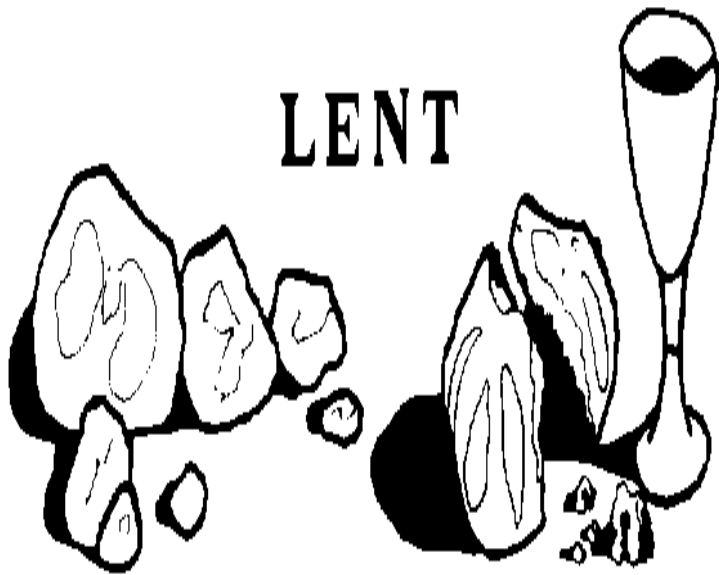

LENT...begins with Ash Wednesday on Feb. 14. It is a day of **fast** and **abstinence**. It's the responsibility for those 14 yrs. of age and older to **abstain from meat** on this day and also **each Friday** during Lent. It is also the responsibility of those ages 18—59 to fast. **Fasting** means to have one ordinary meal & eat two other times during the day—just enough to maintain strength to do one's everyday duties. Lent is a time for each person to seek appropriate acts of self-denial, spiritual exercise, attendance @ daily Mass, reading scripture, praying the rosary, etc. **Fridays during Lent there will be a 7 am Mass @ St. Joseph's.**
