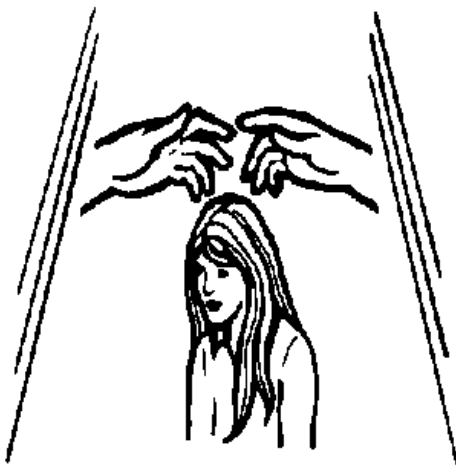
### **The Day Is Near...Parish Auction...2 weeks from today!**
