Sacrament of Reconciliation: One half hour before each weekend Mass or anytime by appointment

As We Return... to Ordinary Time our readings tell us about the compassion God shows to us. In our first reading from Isaiah, we hear language that is tender, compassionate and definitive. The Lord tells us the people of Isaiah's day—and to us today—that we will not be called “forsaken.” Our land will not be “desolate.” The Lord wants to call us “delightful” and “loved.” In our second reading St. Paul teaches us that the Spirit gives us different gifts, such as teaching, knowledge, healing or amazing faith. We are given these gifts to help further the work and the mission of the church and to serve others in the midst of our daily lives. Our Gospel gives us the story of the wedding feast at Cana. It is here that Jesus performs His first miracle. It is Mary who notices the problem with the wine. It is Mary who wants to protect this young couple from undue anxiety. Thus, she steps in and is persistent with Jesus. So, our readings tell us one important truth: Our God delights in each of us and loves us and He shows this by giving us the grace to serve others. This is the way we begin Ordinary Time!!! Have a Blessed Ordinary Time!
