***In Our Reading...***from the Acts of the Apostles, we find disciples saying that converts had to follow Mosaic practices. Many times new ideas come from younger people and if we don’t listen to these ideas they think we don’t want them to participate. In our Gospel, Jesus tells us He leaves us peace. However, if we aren’t willing to listen to others and if we demand things be done our way, then perhaps we will create “dissent and debate.” With this then, we may now know peace. 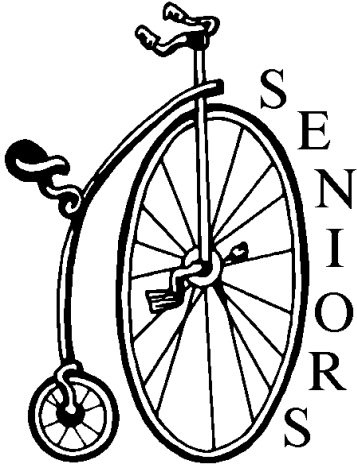

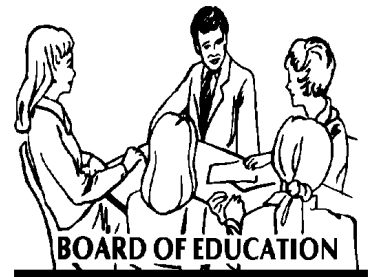
