

Mass Intentions 2020

In order to comply with the Archdiocese of New Orleans Policies regarding Mass Intentions, please note the following:

Sunday and Vigil Masses: Saturday 4:00 p.m.; Sunday 8:00 a.m. & 10:30 a.m.

- **“Pro Populo” Mass:** Father is required to offer 1 Mass per weekend without stipend for the parishioners of St. Anthony. No other intentions will be accepted for this Mass. This Mass will rotate weekly. Please see the reverse of this sheet for those dates.
- **Multi-Intention Masses:** The other two Masses will be “Multi-Intentioned” Masses; meaning more than one person may request this Mass be said for their intentions.

Weekday Masses: Monday 9:00 a.m.; Tuesday 6:00 p.m.; Wednesday 6:30 a.m., Thursday 6:00 p.m., & Friday 9:00 a.m.

- Only one person may request intentions for this Mass. This will be done on a first come, first serve basis. Please indicate on your Mass Intention Request Form if you are open to having your Mass said on a different date.

Holidays and Holy Days of Obligation

- Intentions will not be assigned a specific Mass time, but remembered collectively at all Masses said for the holy day.

Stole Fee Donations for a Mass

- The usual donation for a Mass intention is \$5.00.

Archdiocese of New Orleans Policy on Mass Intentions

In compliance with the decree from the congregation for the Clergy, the following policy is the policy of the Archdiocese of New Orleans regarding Mass intentions:

- 1. Each pastor is to celebrate Mass every Sunday for the parishioners of his parish. This is to be the only intention for the Mass.*
- 2. For all other Masses, one intention is to be accepted.*
- 3. However, at each place of worship, there may be two Masses per week celebrated for more than one intention. These may be any two Masses. The Masses may be on a weekend or a weekday. They need not be the same Mass each week. There is no limit to the number of intentions for these two Masses.*
- 4. Donors are to be aware that their Mass intention will be celebrated at a multi-intentional Mass. They are to freely consent to combining their offerings. The place and time for the celebration of these two Masses are to be made public.*
- 5. The usual donation for a Mass intention is \$5.00. It is strongly recommended that priests celebrate Mass for the intentions of the Christian faithful, especially the needy, even if a lesser amount or no offering has been received.*
- 6. Although Mass offerings are to be accepted, all appearance of trafficking or commerce is to be entirely excluded from Mass offerings. Mass offerings are not to be kept by the individual priest but are remitted to the parish.*
- 7. It is not appropriate to accept more intentions than the number which will be satisfied in a year.*
- 8. Each place of worship is to maintain a special book in which is accurately listed the number of Masses to be celebrated, the intention, the stipend, and their celebration. The dean will examine this book during his visitation.*
