Easter Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 12 Noon for private prayer,

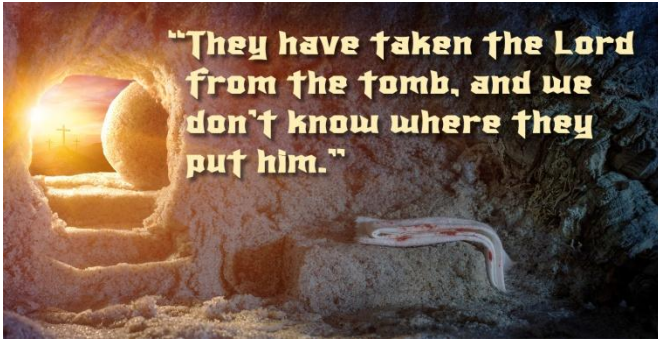
