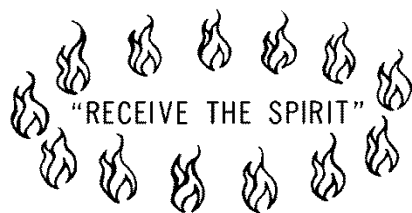
Today is the Peter's Pence Collection, a worldwide
