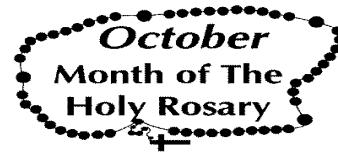

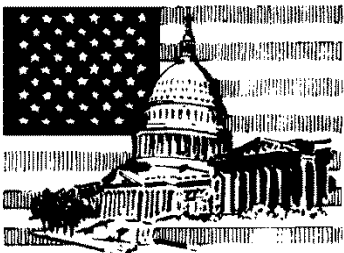
Pray the Rosary for World Peace.
