Ash Wednesday, February 17, complete **Fasting and Abstinence** is to be observed by all Catholics ages 18-59 years old. **Fasting** is one full meal, two smaller meals not equal to a full meal and not eating between meals, liquids are allowed. **Abstinence**, a penitential practice refraining from the consumption of meat, is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years of age and older on Good Friday and Fridays during Lent.
