Hurricane Season Tips:

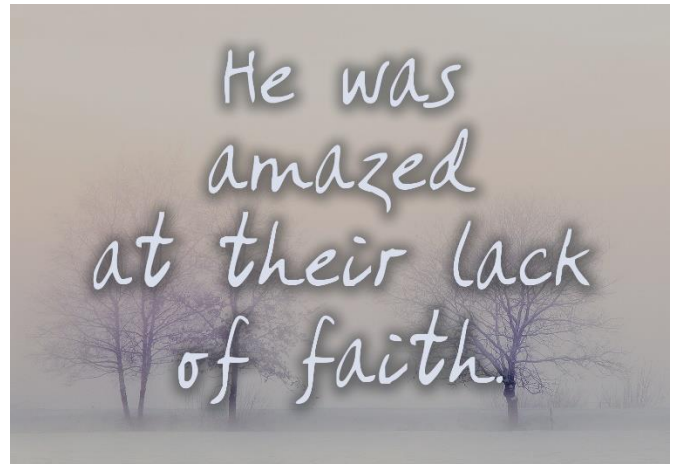
- If the Emergency Management Office Recommends evacuating, take their advice.

- Secure doors and garage from inside.
- Leave a note, a telephone call, text, or email to your family when you have evacuated and WHERE you plan to go.
- Listen to the radio; check your smart phone or computer for the latest news.
