#### *Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

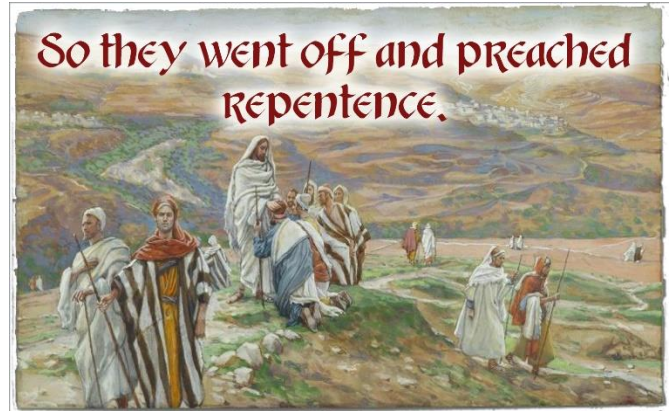

- Listen to the radio; check your smart phone or computer for the latest news.
