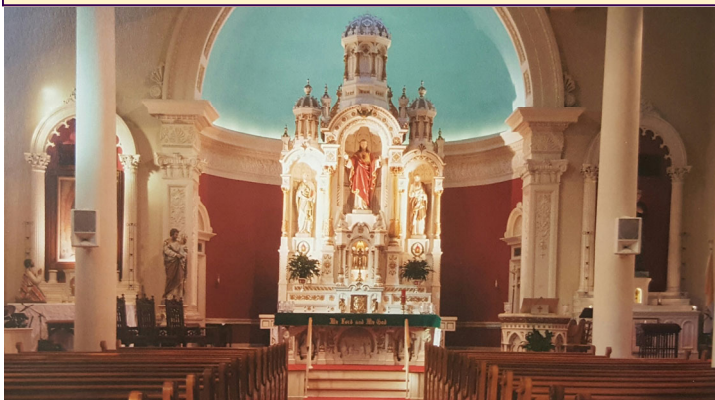

A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at
Blessed Seelos Parish:

The Gospel for today has a simple liturgical flavor to it. The famous two disciples who had been traumatized by the death of Jesus and so were returning to the safety of Emmaus here are pictured as relating the experience of being spun around by their meeting with Jesus, Who had broken bread with them. Their hearts were on fire during this intimate liturgy and so back they come to relate their homiletic story. During this relating, Jesus shows up and shows off by convincing His congregation that He is really present to them in His humanity and divinity. Jesus then does the historical review, proving from the Holy Writings that He would have to suffer. Then, as results with any good homily, the minds of the little congregation were opened with understanding. This is all very intimate and comforting of course. Intimacy has consequences and Jesus ends the liturgy with a definite Dismissal Rite. "Get out of here and preach repentance and the forgivingness of God, beginning right here, right outside that door." I hear many Catholics, when asked, define themselves as Catholics by the confident statement, "Yes, I go to mass". That hurts my ears. That is similar to one of the listeners in today's Gospel saying that he was there when Jesus ate the bread so that makes him a disciple, a follower and that's all. I would love hearing someone define themselves as a Catholic by saying, "Yes, I get sent personally and communally by the missioning experience of the reception of the Word and Eucharist."

El evangelio de hoy tiene sabor litúrgico. Los discípulos de Emaús relatan su experiencia regresando a Jerusalén después de haber descubierto a Jesús en la fracción del pan. Sus corazones ardían al escuchar la palabra. Durante su conversación, Jesús se aparece de nuevo y los reafirma en su humanidad y divinidad. Jesús entonces hace un recuento de la historia de la salvación. Como con toda buena homilía, la mente de los discípulos se abre y entienden. Pero esta intimidad tiene consecuencias. Jesús termina la liturgia con un rito de mandarlos a predicar y a compartir la palabra. Muchos Católicos se definen como Católicos solo por ir a Misa. Eso sería como si los discípulos en el evangelio de hoy dijeran que por haber estado con Jesús cuando comió y bebió con ellos eso los hace discípulos. Me encantaría oír mas cristianos que se definan como Católicos porque se sienten mandados personalmente a predicar el evangelio de Cristo.
