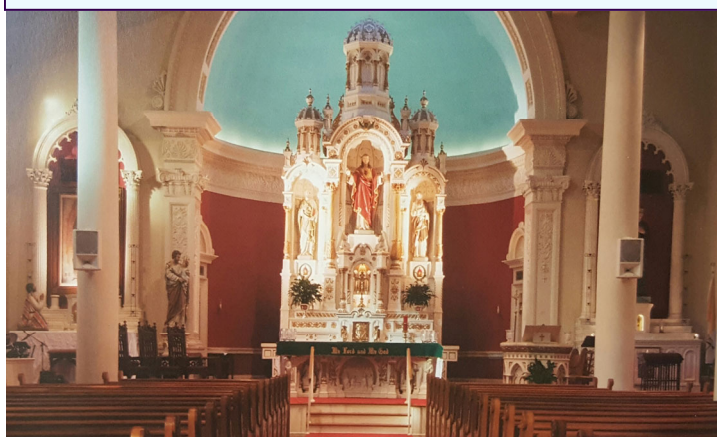

## A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at  
Blessed Seelos Parish:

In the Gospel for today, Jesus speaks to his disciples the parable of the crafty, shrewd, wasteful, cunning, tricky steward. We meet him at a time in his life that causes an abrupt change in his actions. He essentially was accused by his master of unsound business practices. Suddenly he was faced with the loss of his job, his social standing, and even his future livelihood. This was no longer a small matter. His response was unexpected, but shrewd. While he still had the power to do so, he slashed the amounts that they owed the master. He, thereby, assured that he would be asked into their homes, and possibly, would even be employed by them. Why did Jesus praise the actions of this man? Jesus is telling us that this is an example of behavior that is considered to be good practice by those who are not “Children of the Light.” The steward did the best that he could while in the service of money and those who control it. Yet we cannot serve two masters. While our allegiance is divided between what pleases God, and what will merely increase our personal wealth, or social standing, we are not “in the light.” As Christians, we should go beyond just being shrewd.

Jesús lo que nos dice es que este no es el comportamiento de los hijos de la luz. El empresario astuto hizo lo mejor que pudo mientras estaba al servicio del dinero y de los que lo controlaban. Sin embargo, no podemos servir a dos amos. Si nuestra lealtad está dividida entre Dios y la riqueza, no estamos en la luz. Como cristianos no nos podemos conformar con solo ser sagaces.*

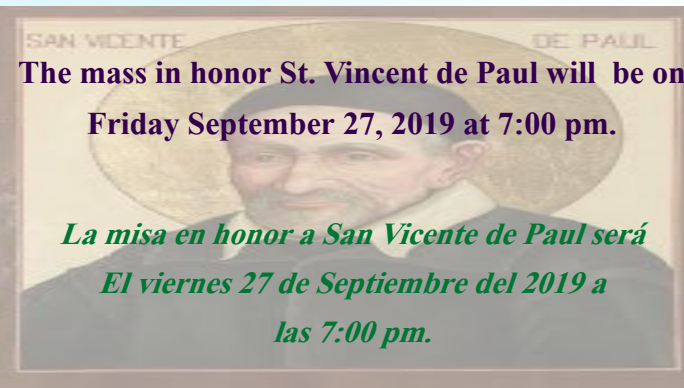
