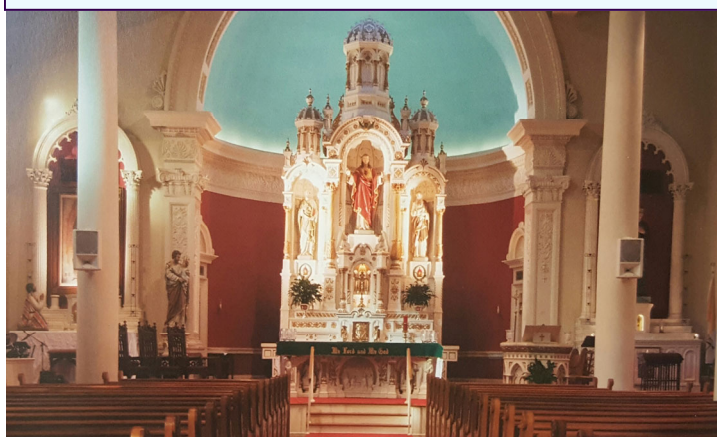

## A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at  
Blessed Seelos Parish:

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the Pharisees a story. I stop short of saying "a story about" since that answer depends on one's perspective. Is this a story about a rich man, or is this a story about a poor man, Lazarus? The unnamed rich man in this story is surrounded by every material comfort. He seemingly wants for nothing. By contrast, seeing this as the story of the poor man, Lazarus, offers a different perspective. He sits at the door of the rich man—a poor man, hungry, thirsty, sore-ridden, wanting for even the most basic things. Lazarus seeks not even a meal at the rich man's table but, rather, the scraps that fall from it. That dogs lick his sores seems to position these dogs as more caring of Lazarus than the rich man. Lazarus is meek, receives whatever may come his way, and is received into Heaven. After both men have died, the rich man asks Abraham to "send Lazarus" to comfort him. He knows by name the man who sat at his door, whom he chose to ignore. Abraham has no pity on the rich man. So, who is this story about? This story is about each of us. Think about it. We can be Lazarus at times or the rich man at times. Who you choose to be, will have eternal consequences.

*En el evangelio de hoy, Jesús hace un cuento. No digo "un cuento de..." ya que la respuesta depende de nuestra perspectiva. ¿Es esta historia sobre un rico sin nombre o sobre Lázaro? El rico del cuento tiene todos los bienes materiales posibles. No necesita nada. Sin embargo, si el cuento es sobre Lázaro, eso nos ofrece una perspectiva diferente—un pobre hombre, hambriento, sediento, lleno de llagas, buscando las cosas más básicas. Lázaro ni piensa sentarse a la mesa con el rico, pero comer las migajas que caían de su mesa en el suelo. Los perros le lamen sus llagas y parecen preocuparse más por Lázaro que el rico. Lázaro es humilde, recibe lo que puede, y es recibido en el Cielo. Cuando ambos hombres mueren, el rico le pide a Abraham que le "mande a Lázaro" para confortarlo. Él conoce por nombre al hombre que se sentaba a su puerta, a quien quiso ignorar. Abraham no tiene ninguna compasión con el rico. Así que, ¿de quien es este cuento? Este cuento es de cada uno de nosotros. Podemos ser Lázaro a veces y el rico a veces. Quien tu decidas ser, tendrá consecuencias eternas. Piénsalo.*
