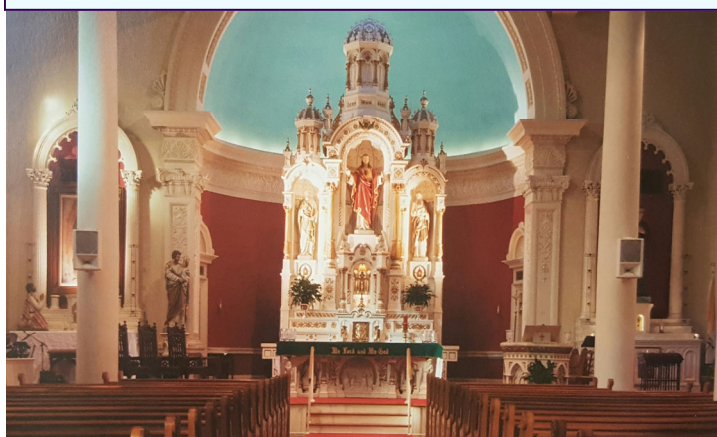

A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at
Blessed Seelos Parish:

In the Gospel verse today we are told to give thanks to God in all circumstances. In the first reading Naaman gives thanks and gifts for his cure. In the Gospel, the Samaritan leper who thanks Jesus is told that his faith has saved him. Every day we enjoy the miracle of life. Every day we wake up we should thank God for everything we are given. What else should we do? It seems that the other thing we must do, which relates to this Gospel passage, is that we need to act. I can't imagine that the nine other lepers that were healed were not grateful for the gift of healing they received. It was not as if leprosy was an inconsequential disease! But what they did not do was take the long journey back to thank the one who performed this miracle on them. Only one went the extra mile, perhaps more than a mile! Let us not just be thankful but also do what is right.

No es como si la lepra fuera cualquier tipo de enfermedad. Pero lo que no hicieron fue coger la larga jornada de regreso para agradecerle en persona al autor de sus sanaciones. ¡Solo uno de ellos camino la milla extra, mejor dicho, varias millas extras! No solo seamos agradecidos, pero también hagamos lo que es correcto en nuestras vidas. **Fr. José Ignacio***
