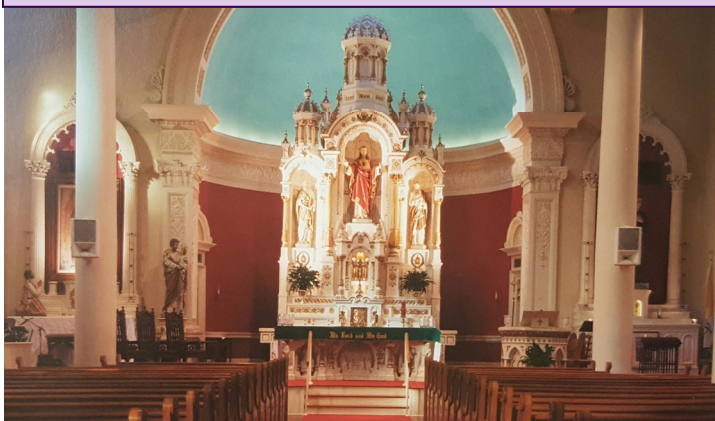

A letter from the Pastor



My dear People at
Blessed Seelos Parish:

Today is Palm Sunday or better known, since the liturgical reform of the Catholic Church, as Passion Sunday. Passion because the Passion of the Lord Jesus is read today in all churches, this year Matthew's version, but also because our Christian life must be lived with the passion, or with passion in mind. We should be passionate about our faith. The Lord Jesus does not suffer his Passion every year, as much as we would like to think like that. The Lord is Risen! Yet, we do well remembering each year His sacrifice for each one of us and our salvation. He was passionate about His love for us, and so should we be passionate about our love for Him. As we listen to the Passion narrative, no matter how we do that this year, let us enter into the drama, so that we can feel the same passion that the Lord felt for our love.

Question for meditation: Have I ever been passionate about something? Bring that feeling to your faith in God.

Reflection for parents with children: Learn how to discover the talents of your children, and motivate them to put those talents to good use.

Al escuchar este año la narración de la Pasión de Cristo, no importa como lo hagamos, entremos en el drama, para así poder sentir la misma pasión que el Señor sintió por nuestro amor.

Pregunta para meditar: ¿He sentido pasión por algo en mi vida? Traiga ese sentimiento a su vida de fe.

Reflexiones para los padres con hijos: Aprenda a como descubrir los talentos de sus hijos, y motívenlos a poner esos talentos en buen uso.
