This initiative was based upon research conducted called the National Study of Youth & Religion. Amongst other findings, that study showed that "the single most important influence on the religious and spiritual lives of adolescents is their parents." Master Catechist, Sabrina Harper will facilitate a workshop based on these

findings which were instrumental in influencing the leadership at St. Matthias Church to shift its focus from child-centered faith formation, to family-centered faith formation.
