RITE OF ORDINATION

CALLING AND ELECTION OF THE CANDIDATE

After the candidate has been presented and testified to be worthy, Archbishop Cordileone declares him Elect for the Diaconate in the following words:

Archbishop: Relying on the help of the Lord God and our Savior Jesus Christ,
we choose this man, our brother, for the Order of the Diaconate.

All: Thanks be to God.

HOMILY

PROMISES OF THE ELECT

Please stand

The Archbishop questions the candidate about his willingness to accept the responsibilities of the diaconal office. Kneeling before the Archbishop, the candidate promises respect and obedience to the Archbishop and his successors.

LITANY OF SUPPLICATION

Please kneel

The candidate lies prostrate in acknowledgement of his dependence upon God and as an expression of his surrender to the will of God.

The assembly kneels as the cantors invoke the intercession of the Saints.

LAYING ON OF HANDS AND PRAYER OF ORDINATION

Please stand

Together, the Laying On of Hands and the Prayer of Ordination are the heart of the Ordination Rite. In the ancient sacramental sign of our invocation of the Holy Spirit, the Archbishop imposes hands upon the Elect.

The assembly is invited to prayer within the great silence which accompanies the Laying on of Hands and which unites this gesture to the Prayer of Ordination which completes it.

INVESTITURE

Please sit

The newly ordained deacon is vested in a dalmatic and stole, the vestments which represent the diaconate.

HANDING ON OF THE BOOK OF THE GOSPELS

The deacon goes to the Archbishop and kneels before him.

The Archbishop places the Book of the Gospels in his hands and says:

Receive the Gospel of Christ, whose herald you have become.

Believe what you read, teach what you believe, and practice what you teach.

FRATERNAL KISS OF PEACE

The Archbishop gives the fraternal kiss of peace to the newly Ordained.
