# Seeing Initiation Ministry with 20/20 Vision

Adopting a theme of a metaphorical mountaintop view, this three-session institute will focus on a reflective view of the beautiful vision presented in the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*. New and experienced initiation ministers will join in prayer and discussion, sharing best practices and common struggles. All are invited to recharge and reenergize to help us better appreciate the transformative power of the baptismal catechumenate.

### SESSION ONE August 16, 2021

**Starting with the end.** Ultimately, what is our goal in this ministry? How do we measure success in our parish community? This session will invite participants to start by looking at the end: living mystagogical lives that meditate on the Gospel, share in the Eucharist, and perform acts of charity.

### SESSION TWO August 23, 2021

**Un-complicating our ministry.** Let's take the time to ask ourselves, "is my RCIA process in line with the Church's vision of initiation ministry?" For many of us, we are making the catechumenate harder on ourselves because we have lost sight of the relatively simple task of making disciples.

### SESSION THREE August 30, 2021

**Renewing our parishes.** In this session, we will unpack the power of the baptismal catechumenate and its intended influence on all of parish life. By deliberately infusing this ancient process into our faith formation offerings for adults, families, and children, we will experience a transformation in our communities.
