Deacon Gerald DuPont Receives Award

Our own Deacon Gerald DuPont was presented the 2018 Richard Cardinal Cushing Medal for the Advancement of Church Leadership at the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) awards celebration in Washington, D.C. on October 29. The award recognized Deacon DuPont "for his contributions that advance Church research through active support of research and the understanding of its uses."



CARA recognized the landmark study which was conducted as part of the 50th anniversary of the renewal of the diaconate in 2018. Deacon DuPont proposed, organized, and helped conduct this research and its interpretation. The study helps focus attention and increase understanding about the evolving role of diaconal ministry in the Church in the United States.
