EMs & Lectors – Please-arrange for a sub if you find you will be away when you are scheduled.

Corporals –Large Corporal is on top of Chalice assembly. Smaller one underneath. Deacon first places the larger one in the center of the Altar and then places the smaller one to the side for the cups (Per Fr. Juan).

EMs – when an adult asks for a blessing, just raise your hand after returning Host to the Ciborium and say “May God Bless You.” Do not touch children or adults! Do not bend down to bless a child accompanying an adult. Only the Priest or Deacon can do that.

EMs – When moving around with the cup, for example when following the Priest or Deacon who goes into the congregation to give Communion to someone, please place your purificator and your hand over the cup as you walk as a sign of reference. Same when carrying a ciborium.

Also, it is only the Priest or Deacon who brings the Host to someone in the congregation. An EM with the cup or chalice follows.
