Morning Health Screening

If the form is not completed and your child arrives to school, you will be called for pick up. Doctor Appointments

Bernie's Pretzels

Saint Eugene School will once again be selling Bernie's Pretzels for snack. The pretzels will be come from Bernie's individually wrapped. Order pretzels by the month. Due dates and the cost will be listed on the monthly calendar. If you wish to order, you may do so either by check (made out to Saint Eugene School) or exact cash in an envelope labeled with your child's name and grade.

Dress Code

Winter uniforms will begin on Monday, October 26. As always, if the weather turns colder before that date, the students may move to the winter uniform.

Box Tops

The Box Tops for Education Program has changed. Box Tops now has a mobile app to scan your store receipt. Download the app, <u>Box Tops for Education</u> from the App Store, find St. Eugene School, and scan your receipt. Box Top earnings are identified and automatically updated at BTFE.com. The App is very easy to use and you can see your earnings immediately. The money received from Box Tops is used to purchase gym equipment.

Help Our School and Receive Tuition Assistance SCRIP Sales = Tuition Assistance

Buying SCRIP is a great way to save money on your tuition. You receive a percentage back for each gift card you purchase. Just be sure to keep the vouchers. Families have saved \$500 or more off their tuition by purchasing SCRIP. You may purchase SCRIP through the school by filling out the order form and sending it along with your payment, in a sealed envelope to school on Thursday. Your order will be filled and returned on Friday. Please be sure to label the envelope with your name and SCRIP. See our website for more details.
