Dear Parents and Guardians:

Hope all of you are well and have enjoyed summer. We are now looking at the different ways we can bring our faith to the children and keep them safe at the same time. In doing so, we have some information we would like to share.

1. Would your child like to come back in person or virtually? Please fill out on your forms so we can have a record of it.
2. We will be putting out a schedule only few months at a time so as to keep current.
3. CCD will be done only twice in a month with the duration of classes being shorter in length. Children will be able to choose coming in one week and virtually one week – these will alternate so that it allows the children an opportunity at both. They can attend one or the other or both. The requirement will be twice a month whichever way they choose.
4. If you choose to attend in person but cannot make it that day, please reach out to us so we can send you a link to join virtually the following week.
5. Attendance will be taken at both, class and virtual secessions. Communion and Confirmation children – it is very important for you to attend in person or virtually or we will be forced to have you wait out a year.
6. In person class will be held at 10:15AMto 11:00AM. This change is due to the change in our mass schedule
7. Forms will be available on our website for registration. The price will remain the same **\$25.00 per child and \$35.00 per family**. Please drop off forms to the rectory – you can put it in the slot in the door for a no contact way.
8. Once again you need to let us know if you want to go virtual or in person.
9. Masks will be required for the duration of the in person classes – they must be worn as soon as you enter the building.
10. Confirmation children - forms are available online. Please print and start to send in your registration and rest of the paperwork.

Thank you all for working with us as we plan for the upcoming year. We will stay in touch as things begin to take shape.
