

Your overall grade for this class will be based on the following:

5TH READING

- **Class Participation/Classwork/Homework: 20%** of your grade
 - **Participation:** Be in class on time, ready to learn. When the bell rings, you should have only your Reading material on your desk. Contribute to the overall learning environment by your attention and self-disciplined behavior.
 - **Classwork:** You will have a variety of work and activities, some done alone, some in pairs, some in small groups. Be sure to listen to directions and work with others. An important part of our “work” will be making sure your classwork is done and properly in your folder/workbook. This will help you in case you need to refer back to it when you are completing your homework.
 - **Homework:** Stay on top of your reading. You will be participating in the Accelerated Reading program again this year. You will need to earn 5 points each quarter. The points and the comprehension will each count as a quiz grade. So that is 2 quiz grades right there. Along with this you will have homework for our Reading class itself.
- **Vocabulary: 20%** of your grade
 - You will have vocabulary that we will learn with each story we read. You will have a vocabulary test on each of them. You will receive a vocabulary list before we start each story, or you will find it in your Google Classroom. Don't wait to start familiarizing yourself with them. Start looking at them as soon as you receive them.
- **Skills Test: 35%** of your grade
 - There will be a test at the end of each chapter and each unit. The test schedule will be posted on the calendar in the hallway across from my room, as well as online. Be sure to pay attention in class and review material throughout the chapter regularly so your final preparation for the tests will be easier.
- **Quarter Exam: 25%** of your grade
 - This will cover material for the entire quarter. You will have a study guide to help you prepare.

Be sure to use correct grammar and penmanship on all your assignments. This is part of your grade!
