

# COCHON de LAIT DRESS DOWN DAY

Dress Down Day Rules, as stated in the Student Handbook:

For PK1 & PK2...

- May wear whatever works best for your child with their 2020 Cochon shirt.

For Grades PK3 -7<sup>th</sup>...

- May wear 2020 Cochon shirt with full-length **blue** jeans (no skorts, jeggings or Capris; jeans may not be overly tight, distressed, or have holes).
- Students may wear tennis shoes with full backs. Tennis shoes may **not** have working lights or built in rollers. No slides, sandals, Crocs, or Topsiders. If in doubt, wear the regulation school shoe. Grades who typically wear Velcro-fastened shoes should wear that type of shoe.
- Alternative outerwear is permissible, but not with high school logos.
- Students may wear any type of socks they choose.
- Alternative hair accessories for girls are okay, as long as they are not deemed distracting.

Students who choose not to participate are to wear full, regular uniform. Students who choose not to cooperate shall forfeit the privilege of participating in future dress-down days (prepaid or free) for the rest of the school year.
