1. What safety measures are in place at school?
 - Teachers check students' temperatures upon arrival, before entering classroom.
 - Desks are distanced in the classroom.
 - Extra teachers come to the classroom so students stay in the same desk all day.
 - Masks are worn and hands are sanitized anytime students enter and exit the building/classroom.
 - At recess, classes are separated so students remain in their cohort groups. Playground equipment is not being used.
 - Desks are disinfected at the end of each day as well as high-touch areas (light switch, door handles)
 - Personal items like markers, scissors, and glue are kept in seat sacks and not passed out.
2. How are Chrome Books being utilized?
 - Students know how to log into their devices and Google Classroom and know how to find and complete assignments in Google Classroom.
 - Digital lessons/assignments are done in class on a regular basis so the students are comfortable doing this should the need arise to go back to at-home learning.
 - Students have personal sets of earbuds to use with their Chrome Books that are kept in their seat sacks.
 - Should the need arise to move to at-home/hybrid learning, students who do not have a device at home will take their Chrome Books home to use for their assignments.
3. Where can I find important information as it becomes available?
 - Be sure to check www.steddyschool.com on a regular basis for important information and updates.
 - Teacher websites are updated weekly.
 - Google Classroom will have all lessons/assignments if we move to at-home learning.
 - Check silver folder daily for important notes and information. Weekly conduct grades will be posted in the folder. All digital login information is taped inside the folder.
4. How often do I need to check Google Classroom?
 - During in-school instruction, Google Classroom only needs to be accessed from home if an assignment is given on the homework sheet.
 - If an in-class quiz is given on Google Classroom (indicated on homework sheet), you can view your child's grade in Google Classroom.
 - If at-home learning takes place, Google Classroom should be checked daily for lessons and assignments.
