

ART FOLDER homework assignments for the SECOND nine weeks

Students may CHOOSE (except where specified) the media (Crayons, colored pencils, markers, paint, etc.) of their choice to do homework. **To get full credit**, effort must be evident, the page must be full. If the main subject is too small, consider doing several and/or include some sort of background of simple color, lines or patterns. Borders are nice too! If the work is well done and fills MOST of the page, SOME empty space is OK. *A Small thing floating in a sea of empty whiteness will not get graded well.* Art supplies should be available at home. If a class does not meet because of a holiday, the assignment must still be completed and will be checked along with the next week's HW when you return.

Due week of October 18 - (no school so Middle school brings it with next week's HW)

Draw and color your favorite ride or booth at the Cochon De Lait. If you don't attend, make one up.

Due week of October 25 – Design your own Halloween costume or mask.

Due week of November 1 – Saint's Birthday card. The Saints were "born" on November 1, 1966 so it's the Saints 55th birthday this year. Design and color a folding card for the saints' birthday on November first.

Due week of November 8 – Geometric shape overlap. Draw several different geometric shapes (squares, triangles, circles, octagons, hexagons, etc. Have some shapes overlap other shapes and color the overlap area in different colors than the shapes you overlapped. For example. Have a red triangle overlap a blue circle and color the overlap area purple. Fill the page with shapes.

Due week of November 15 - Fun turkey. Create a fun turkey for Thanksgiving.. Give him clothes if you want or design unique feathers etc. Give him a name.

Due week of November 29 – Textures. There are many different kinds of textures: Hard, bumpy, soft, rough, patterns on surfaces etc. Use the rubbing technique to put as many textures on your page as you can. Pencil works great but you can use anything. Simply place your paper over something with texture and rub your pencil, crayon etc. over the surface. Coins, leaves, wood, walls with texture, the possibilities are endless. Have fun.

Due week of December 6 – American Artist Mary Cassatt often painted and drew pictures of mothers and their children. Create and color a drawing that shows a mother and child. It can be human OR animal. Make sure to include some sort of background.

Due week of December 13 – FREE DRAW! Subject can be anything to do with Christmas.
